## 22 Södergårdarna




Norrby is a very old 'bolby' where self-owned farmers

live on their own farms. The villages probably arose as early as the Iron Age (500 BC to 1050 AD). During the Middle Ages, two earlier older villages, Nedrebyn in Bergby and Litsleby in Norrby, disappeared. Norrby is one of the larger villages in Häverö parish, the name Norrby has been known since 1429. Originally, Norrby village was located around the hill where **Södergårdarna** is located today. During the Middle Ages, several farms were divided and moved out. On the map of Norrby from 1780 we can see the farms' relocated locations. Södergårdarna today consists of 3 smaller farms next to each other.
